ROADWORK AND CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

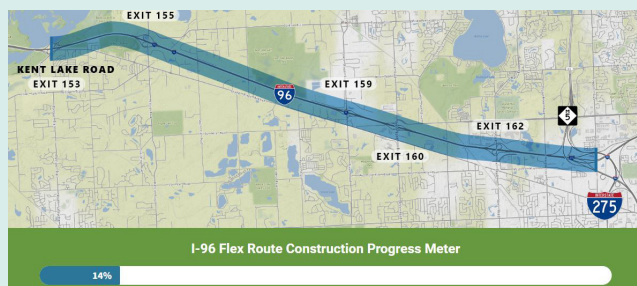
Currie Road
